I would like to inform you that earlier there was a need of issuing the fresh GPF Accounts Numbers in respect of erstwhile Class IV employees on their promotion to the posts under Group C Category and accordingly series of the GPF number was changed from DGA to DG category.

After the recommendations of the 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission erstwhile Class IV employees have been re designated a Group C employees but on their promotion to the same category the requisitions of issue of fresh GPF numbers are still being submitted by the departments whereas after the re designation of these employees as Group C the GPF Number issue under DGA series should be continued.

The matter has been reviewed in this office and it has been decided that erstwhile Class IV employees on their promotion to other Group C posts may be allowed to retain the GPF Number already allotted under DGA Series.

**Dear Shri Parida,**

1. I am writing with reference my telephonic talk with you yesterday.
2. As you are aware, road safety is an issue of serious concern both for the government and society considering its magnitude and consequent severe negative impact on the economy, public health, and general welfare of the people, particularly low-income groups. Every year, road crashes in the country result in about 1.5 lakh deaths and 5 lakh injured.
3. India is a signatory to the Brasilia Declaration and is committed to reduce the number of road fatalities by 50 percent by the year 2020. In the year 2015, the UN General Assembly adopted 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, which highlights road safety in development goals.
4. Keeping in view the above, the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MORTH) has taken a major step towards development of National Centre for Road Safety (NCRS) at the Asian Institute of Transport Development (AITD). This initiative is first of its kind in the country and aims at addressing road safety issues in a multi-disciplinary perspective.
5. One of the important activities relates to training of 4,000 government officials in road safety and 1,500 in road safety audit. I am enclosing a letter written by the Ministry to the Principal Secretaries, Engineer-in-Chiefs and Chief Engineers of various state governments for inviting nominations along with schedule for training programme being organized by AITD.
6. You will observe from the attached letter of the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways that the entire cost including boarding / lodging and study materials would be borne by AITD while the concerned department would bear the expenditure towards TA/DA.
7. I would like to invite your kind attention to the following forthcoming four training courses going to be held at AITD, Asia Bhawan, Sector 9, Dwarka, New Delhi and request you to send the nominations of 10 to 15 engineers for each course to [khushal2084@yahoo.com](mailto:khushal2084@yahoo.com) (MORTH) with a copy to [asianinstitute.del@gmail.com](mailto:asianinstitute.del@gmail.com) (AITD).

8. The courses will be coordinated by Shri D. P. Gupta, former Director General (Road Development), Ministry of Road Transport and Highways.
9. I shall be grateful if you can send the nominations at the earliest. You may like to nominate a senior officer of PWD of the Government of NCT of Delhi who will coordinate with NCRS in matters relating to training.
10. Some of the governments including Goa, Tamil Nadu and Rajasthan have requested for arranging training courses for their engineers separately. If you wish, we can do so as well for NCT of Delhi. In this case also the entire cost of training will be borne by AITD while the concerned department will bear the expenditure, if any, on account of TA/DA.



MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 19/06/2018 AT 04:00 PM UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SPECIAL SECRETARY (GAD) IN CONFERENCE ROOM- 3 AT DELHI SECRETARIAT REGARDING ISSUES OF STAFF CAR DRIVERS.

The list of the participants is at Annexure (A).

Special Secretary (GAD) welcomed all officers/official present in the meeting.

Deputy Secretary (Admin), GAD briefed about various issues of Staff Car Drivers one by one. After due deliberations, following decisions were taken:-

**Issue 1:- Nodal Department for taking up matters of drivers in GNCTD.**

Deputy Secretary (GAD) informed that Chief Secretary had already designated GAD as nodal department for co-ordinating various issues of Staff Car Drivers.

**Issue 2:- Removing of ratio from the promotion scheme and promotion should be given as per time fixed for promotion.**

Dy. Secretary (Services) informed that Govt. of NCT Delhi follows DoPT guidelines in this regard, which has prescribed ratio based system of promotion. Hence, it is not possible to do away with it. Representative of the Staff Car Drivers informed that provision of time bound promotions exist. It was decided to make a separate representation in the matter to GAD alongwith relevant policy guidelines of DoPT.

**Issue 3:- Removal of Trade Test from Driver's Promotion Scheme.**

Being an eligibility requirement as per the RRs, the members representing DSVCKS were advised to represent the same separately to GAD, for taking up this matter with DoPT.

**Issue 4:- Drivers should be given same work and same pay scale as in other organization like Supreme Court, High Court, MCD, NDMC and DJB.**

The matter is sub judice in Court, any comments on this issue were not desirable.



**Issue 5:- Govt. Vehicles/Staff Car should be insured.**

Representatives of DSVCKS informed that in some cases of accidents, drivers are many a times directed to pay compensation by courts. Hence, third party insurance of vehicles must be done by Delhi Govt. DS- I, Finance stated that earlier the same proposal was forwarded by GAD and FD gave their opinion on the basis of last 5-10 years statements of comparison (GAD) between amount of insurance Vs amount paid in accidental claims. Now, in view of the demand from the Samiti, FD may review the same on the basis of statement of comparison to be provided by all departments. All the departments were directed by SS(GAD) to furnish information in the matter within 10 days.

(Action: All Departments)

**Issue 6:- Increase of rate of Over Time Allowance (OTA) which has not been increased since 1991.**

It was informed that the issue of increase/grant of OTA to the drivers has been taken up with DoPT in view of orders of DoPT, GoI dated 16.11.2017.

(Action: GAD, Services and Labour Department)

**Issue 7:- To keep a watch on the Workshop authorized for repair of Govt. of Vehicles.**

Transport Department informed that they had circulated a list of authorized workshop in 1990. After that no list has been issued from transport department. Latter, Transport Department has also recommended authorized workshop of Maruti, Toyota etc. After discussion, Transport Department was advised to issue a new list as there appears some ambiguity due to very old list/order.

(Action: Transport Department)

**Issue 8:- Amendment in the RRs of Drivers**

All Departments were advised to expedite the process of amendment of RRs of Staff Car Drivers as per DoPT latest guidelines and implementation of 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission.

(Action: All Departments)

**Issue 9:- Appointment of Sr. Drivers in the Transport Department.**

It was informed by Transport Department that there is no post of Assistant MVI as mentioned by DSVCKS. Moreover, appointment as MVI requires technical qualification as per the RRs and the post of Staff Car Drivers is not a feeder post for MVI.



**Issue 10:- Provide employment on compassionate grounds to dependents of deceased drivers.**

Deputy Secretary (Services) informed that Compassionate appointment for the dependents of deceased employees of all Departments (excluding autonomous body/PSUs/Local bodies) of GNCT of Delhi including of drivers are dealt in accordance with the DoPT guidelines in the matter. Since there is a fixed percentage of total vacancies for appointment on compassionate grounds, all applicants cannot be considered.

**Issue 11:- Recruitment of Drivers against vacant post on urgent basis/ filling up vacancies.**

All Departments were advised to finalize the RRs of Staff Car Drivers at the earliest and initiate process of recruitment of drivers, after amendment of R.R.'s in time bound manner.

(Action: All Departments)

**Issue 12:- Stoppage of Plying private vehicles as taxis in government offices.**

Transport Department informed that plying of private vehicle as taxis in government offices is illegal. All Departments were directed to ensure the compliance of the rules, in this regard.

It is decided in the meeting that all departments may provide the same at their own level, if required due to extreme pollution levels.



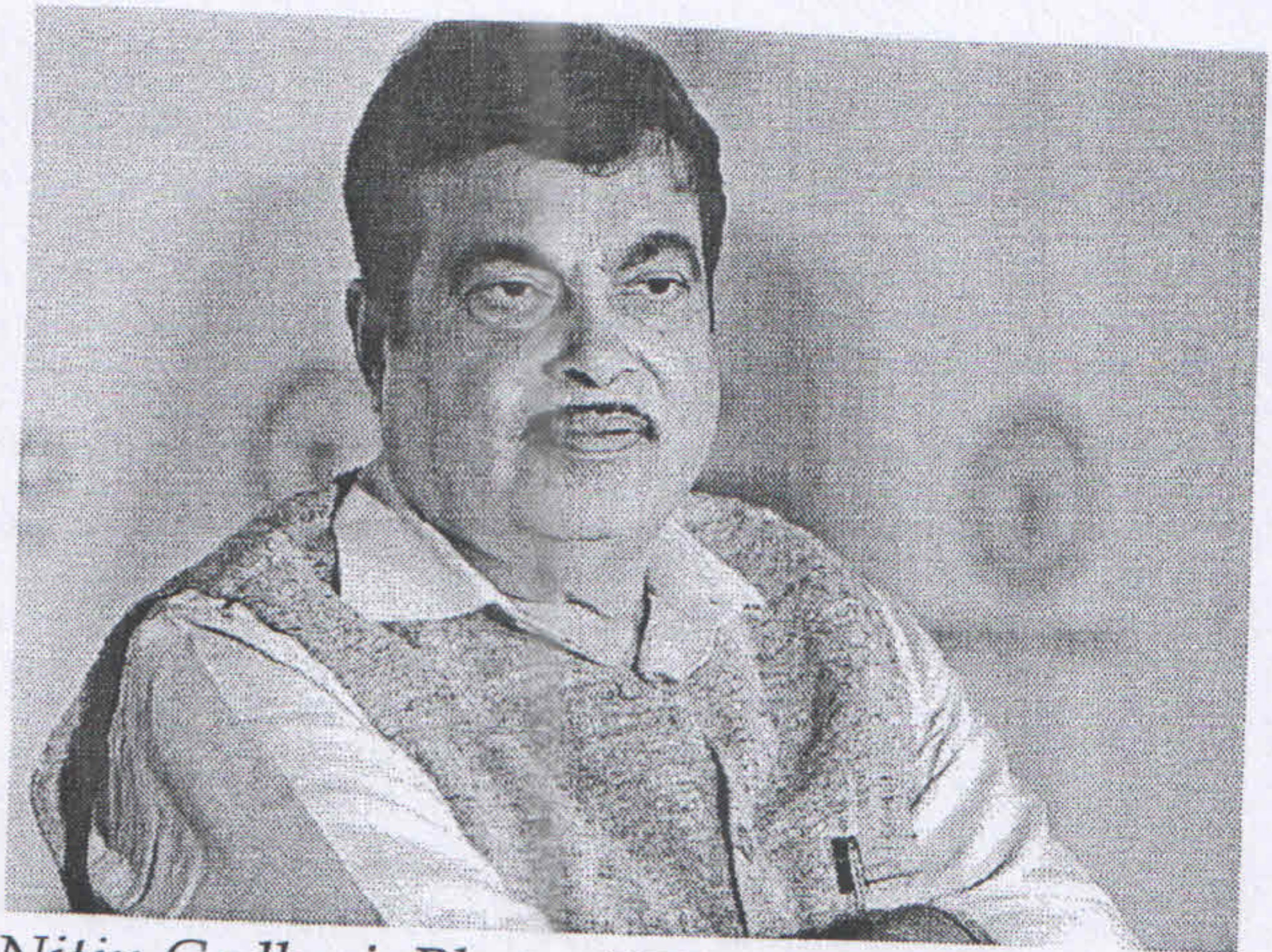
## Transport ministry launches road safety training programme for engineers

*Year 2017 accounted for about 140,000 deaths caused by non-adherence or absence of road safety norms*

The Union ministry of road transport and highways has launched a national programme to train civil engineers and road transport professionals in road safety.

The second batch of engineers completed their training on Friday, raising the number of engineers trained so far to 200. The training is being conducted by the Asian Institute of Transport Development (AITD), with which the ministry has tied up to provide safety training to about 4,000 professionals. The training programme will cover all states and union territories in the country, according to AITD.

Last year accounted for about 140,000 deaths caused by non-adherence or absence of road safety norms.

In another initiative, the ministry has planned to create a dedicated pool of 1,500 road safety auditors. These professionals will be given training and will have to pass a written examination before qualifying as accredited safety auditors.

AITD has already identified 20 academic and professional bodies including IITs across the country to collaborate with it to impart training, with the aim of developing a number of centres of repute in the country. The long-term objective is to build AITD as a national centre for road safety with affiliates across the country.






