Subject: Minutes of the meeting taken by ADG(S&P) on 17-07-2017 regarding regularization of deceased workmen and matters regarding the Judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 28-04-2017 in respect of Double OTA

After welcoming all the participants in the meeting the following issues were dicussed:-

- (i)Regularization matters of deceased workmen who were covered under this Directorate's letter no. 19/176/2004-EC-X dated 11-03-2011 for regularization w.e.f. 11-12-2006 but died before March, 2011 when their regularization orders were issued by this Directorate.
- (ii)Calculation of financial implication w.r.t. the judgement dated 28-04-2017 in SLP(C)No. 14929/2016 and SLP (C) No. 14930/2016 regarding payment of double overtime wages to the Work Charged and Regular Classified employees of CPWD.

Agenda (i) After deliberation with all the participants, in the light of various pending court cases and Judgement dated 24/01/2017 of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C) 4323/2016 & CM 18168/2016 in respect of Anita Devi Vs/Union of India (copy enclosed), it was decided that the deceased Work Charged Employees who could not be regularized before their death, but otherwise covered under the DOPT scheme called Casual Labourers (Grant of Temporary Status and Regularisation) Scheme of Government of India, 1993 and in respect of the deceased persons who were covered under DOPT OM No. 49019/1/2006-Estt.C dated 11-12-2006 as per this Directorate Letter no. 19/176/2004-EC-X dated 11-03-2011 may be treated as deemed regularized subject to their eligibility and availability of vacancy. Post regularization benefits will be admissible as per DOPT O.M.No. 49014/2/2014-Estt.(C) dated 28-07-2016(copy enclosed). All similar cases pending in the Courts shall be settled accordingly so as to reduce unnecessary litigation.
