- (iv) Mission Indradhanush



The undersigned is directed to convey that, Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) has intimated that they have secured one slot for course in 'Global Seismological Observation' for India and the course is tentatively scheduled from 14th January, 2019 to 9th March, 2019. This programme aims to provide participants training opportunities to acquire knowledge and advanced techniques of global seismological observation and to enable them to play an important role in the monitoring system for nuclear tests. This program is designed for governmental organizations which are expected to play an important role in the global monitoring network on nuclear tests.

The essential Qualifications for the nominated candidate should be:-

Nominated by their governments

- Graduates or equivalent with professional experience of more than 3 years in the field of seismology
- Well versed in basic Mathematics such as differentiation and integration
- Have good knowledge of computer
- Be under 45 years of age
- Have a competent command of spoken and written English which is equal to TOEFL CBT, 173, Ibt61 or its equivalent
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally to participate in the Program in Japan.

3. All the expenses related to air tickets, travel insurance, accommodation and training related expenditure will be borne by JICA, Japan. NDMA will not bear any type of expense related to said course.

4. All State Governments/UTs falling under seismic zone IV & V are requested to send nomination of one officer / expert dealing with the subject and who fulfills the eligibility criteria to NDMA alongwith their detailed bio-data/resume at the earliest for further necessary action. Details of the course and other relevant particulars will be sent by NDMA to shortlisted candidate in due-course.



The DoPT, Govt. of India has clarified that "... in cases where MACP falls due on or after 25.07.2016, the revised benchmark of 'Very Good' is to be followed. In other words, the overall grading of the APARs reckonable for grant of MACP should be atleast Very Good".

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Services Department (ACP Cell), GNCTD letter No. 7(106)/2016/Advice/Services/ACP Cell/Part-II/752 dated 25.09.2018 on the abovementioned subject matter and to say that the matter was referred to the Department of Personnel & Training (DoPT) for obtaining the clarification on the issue.

Now, DoP&T has clarified that vide OM dated 28.09.2016 DoP&T has implemented the recommendation of 7th CPC, accepted by the Government for enhancing benchmark for grant of MACP to 'Very Good'. These instructions are applicable w.e.f. 25.07.2016, the date of issue of Government Resolution by D/o Expenditure. Therefore, in cases where MACP fails due on or after 25.07.2016, the revised benchmark of 'Very Good' is to be followed. In other words, the overall grading of the APARs reckonable for grant of MACP should be atleast 'Very Good'.
