Sub: Inspection diary of Shri Dinesh Kumar, Engineer-in-Chief, PWD for the week from 5th to 9th of May 2014.

Ref: No.PS/PWD/119-128 dated 4.3.2014 from PWD Sectt.

5/5/2014: Inspection of pumping stations under Zone M-4.

Pumping stations at Bhairon Road, Tilak Bridge, Vijay Ghat, Rose Garden and Azad Bhawan were inspected where S.E, M-41 and M-45 were present along with their staff. During inspection, it was observed that pumps are in running condition and desilting of sumps and drains are in progress. Concerned staff was directed to complete desilting well in time i.e. before 15/5/2014. All staff for running the pumps during monsoon season, is also to be posted so that there should not be any flooding in the vicinity of these pumping stations.

6/5/2014: Inspection of work at Majnu-ka-Tila.

The work of strengthening of Road No.45 from Metcalf House to Wazirabad was inspected where C.E, M-4, S.E, M-31 were present along with their staff. The quality of work was found satisfactory; however, the procedure aspects were directed to be observed while doing strengthening work. Road side channel is also to be constructed before rainy season. It is preferred that the work is completed before rainy season. Widening and strengthening work of Burari Road from Mall Road to Outer Ring Road was also inspected. It was noticed that at some places, the height of footpath was more than the desired height as per UTTIPEC guidelines. Concerned staff was directed to keep the height of footpath as per UTTIPEC guidelines upto the extent possible. The ongoing drain work should be completed before rainy season.

7/5/2014: Meeting with Hon'ble L.G.

There was a meeting with Hon'ble L.G regarding GTB Hospital and presentation of Health Department; hence no inspection could be done.

8/5/2014: Inspection of Zone M-2 Roads.

Roads in Yamuna Vihar area were inspected where C.E, M-2, S.E, M-21 were present along with their staff. There is water logging problem in Yamuna Vihar Colony where the drain work is in progress. Concerned staff was directed to complete the drain work before monsoon season and ensure that all pumping houses remain operational during rainy season.

There is a proposal to widen the service road of Road No.59 but it has been noticed that there are lot of trees which may not be desired to be cut for widening of service road. The green belt along Road No.59 can be allowed for local area parking wherever possible. Other instructions for removal of malba and repair of potholes were also issued.

9/5/2014: Review meeting of Hon'ble L.G.

No inspection was taken as there was a review meeting of Hon'ble L.G regarding field inspections by various departments.
